



Privacy Notice for Customers
Announced on 25th February 2026

As Pi Securities Public Company Limited (the “Company”, “we”, “us”, and “our”), in its capacity as a data controller under the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019) (the “PDPA”), we place importance on the privacy of our customers (“you”), including personal data and measures to ensure the security of personal data. We wish to assure you that we will properly govern the collection, use, and disclosure (collectively, the “processing”) of your personal data. In addition, to ensure that the processing of your personal data is carried out in accordance with the specified purposes and applicable laws, we have prepared this Privacy Notice (the “Notice”) to explain to you our practices relating to personal data, the reasons for processing your personal data, and your rights as a data subject under the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019) and relevant regulations (the “Data Protection Laws”).

1. Who does this Notice Apply to?

This Notice applies to data subjects whose personal data is processed by the Company, which may include one or more of the following categories of individuals:

- “**Individual customers**” refers to natural persons who have opened securities trading accounts, derivatives trading accounts, or any other types of investment accounts with the Company or are in the process of applying to open such accounts, or intend to use the Company’s investment services, securities trading services, derivatives trading services, or any other financial services. This also includes natural persons whose personal data is collected, used, or disclosed by the Company for the purposes of service provision, transaction execution, legal compliance, regulatory compliance, and communications relating to the relationship between the Company and such customers.
- “**Representatives of customers or juristic persons**” refers to natural persons who act on behalf of individual customers or juristic persons who are customers of the Company, whether as legal representatives, authorized persons, signatories, managers, controllers, directors, employees, or any other persons authorized to contact, coordinate, carry out actions, or conduct any transactions on behalf of such customers or juristic persons. This also includes natural persons whose personal data is collected, used, or disclosed by the Company for the purposes of identity verification, legal compliance, regulatory compliance, transaction execution, or communications relating to the business relationship between the Company and such customers or juristic persons.



2. Sources of Personal Data

The Company generally collects personal data directly from you. However, in certain cases, the Company may receive your personal data from other sources in order to achieve the purpose of processing personal data as described below:

- **Personal data collected directly from you:** Personal data that you have provided directly to the Company, or that arises from or already exists with the Company as a result of your use of products and/or services, contact, service usage, visits, participation in activities, or information inquiries through the Company's service channels and/or communication channels, such as the Company's website, applications, social media accounts, electronic mail, telephone, facsimile, postal mail, seminars, marketing activities, meetings, or any other channels.

- **Personal data collected from other sources**

Personal data that the Company receives or has access to from other sources, such as from other persons or organizations with whom you have contact and have given consent to disclose or transfer such data to the Company, or from government authorities, affiliates, business partners, service providers of business partners, counterparties, as well as public sources (such as the website of the Stock Exchange of Thailand and/or publications in the Royal Gazette), persons with legal authority or rights, or any other persons or entities with whom the Company has legal relationships, for the purposes of processing personal data as specified in this Privacy Notice, for example:

- Collection of data from the Legal Execution Department, the Anti-Money Laundering Office, and/or relevant service providers to verify lists of high-risk persons relating to money laundering and designated persons under anti-money laundering laws
- Collection of data used for identity verification from NDID service providers and for electronic identity proofing and authentication for application users, for the purposes of customer identification and customer due diligence (KYC/CDD) in accordance with legal requirements
- Receipt or exchange of data from securities registrars, banks, other securities companies, or through systems prescribed by regulators (such as the SDEP system) for the purposes of legal compliance, regulatory compliance, risk management, securities transaction execution, and the protection of the legitimate interests of the Company and investors

In the event that you provide personal data of third parties to the Company, such as emergency contacts, reference persons, or other persons related to your employment, meeting representatives, or proxies, you are requested to inform such persons of the details of this Notice and obtain their consent where necessary, or rely on other lawful bases prior to providing such personal data of third parties to the Company.



The Company does not have a policy of intentionally conducting business activities with minors and does not intend to collect personal data from customers who are minors without obtaining consent from their parent or legal guardian as required by law, or from quasi-incompetent or incompetent persons without obtaining consent from their curator or legal guardian as required by law.

If you are a minor, a quasi-incompetent person, or an incompetent person who wishes to enter into a contract or establish a business relationship with the Company, you must obtain consent from your parent, curator, or legal guardian, as applicable, prior to contacting the Company or providing personal data to the Company.

If the Company becomes aware that personal data has been collected from such persons without valid consent in accordance with applicable laws, the Company will promptly delete such personal data, unless the Company has other lawful bases that permit the retention or continued processing of such data.

3. Personal Data Processed by the Company

Personal data refers to information that can identify you either directly or indirectly but does not include data of deceased individuals or data of legal entities.

The Company collects various types of personal data and processes them for different purposes depending on the type of data and the data subject. To inform you of the personal data currently collected by the Company, the data has been categorized as follows:

If you do not cross out or redact the data, the Company may proceed to do so in order to protect your sensitive personal data.

5. Disclosure of Personal Data to External Parties

The Company may need to disclose your personal data to external parties for the purposes stated in this Notice. Such disclosure will be limited to what is necessary, and the Company will implement appropriate measures in accordance with Personal Data Protection Laws.

6. Cross-Border Transfer of Personal Data

In certain cases, The Company may need to transfer your personal data to countries outside Thailand as part of its normal business operations. The Company will use its best efforts to transfer your personal data only to trusted recipients in the destination country and will apply secure measures to ensure appropriate protection of your personal data.

If the destination country does not have adequate personal data protection standards, The Company will implement all necessary and appropriate measures to ensure that the transfer complies with the requirements under the Personal Data Protection Laws.

7. Security Measures

The Company has implemented appropriate security measures for the processing of your personal data. These measures include technical, organizational, and physical safeguards to maintain the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of your personal data.

8. Personal Data Retention

The Company will retain your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected, or for the duration of any contractual or legal relationship between you and The Company, or for the period during which contractual claims may be exercised under the applicable statute of limitations, or for such period as may be required or permitted by law, including retention periods prescribed by regulators for supervisory or inspection purposes.

Once the retention period has expired and/or the company no longer has lawful bases to process your personal data, The Company will proceed to delete or destroy your personal data or anonymize it so that it can no longer be used to identify you. This will be done in accordance with company's internal policies or as required by applicable laws and regulations.

9. Your Rights as a Data Subject

You have the right to exercise various rights concerning your personal data under applicable Personal Data Protection Laws, subject to the conditions and criteria prescribed by such laws. In cases where you are under 20 years of age or have limited legal capacity, your rights may be exercised by a legally authorized representative. In this regard, your rights include the following:

- **Right to Withdraw Consent**

If the Company has requested your consent to process personal data for specific purposes, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, unless there are legal limitations or contractual



obligations that provide benefits to you. Your withdrawal of consent will not affect the collection, use, and/or disclosure of your personal data that was carried out prior to the withdrawal.

- **Right of Access and to Obtain a Copy**

You have the right to access your personal data, request a copy of such personal data, or request the Company to disclose how your personal data was obtained.

- **Right to Data Portability**

You have the right to request your personal data, which is under the responsibility of Country Group, in a format that is readable or usable by automated tools or equipment, and that can be used or disclosed through automated means. You may also request that such data be sent or transferred to other organizations or companies, where technically feasible.

Additionally, you have the right to request that the Company directly send or transfer your personal data in such format to another data controller, unless it is not technically possible to do so. All such actions will be carried out in accordance with the scope and conditions prescribed by the Personal Data Protection Laws.

- **Right to Object to Processing**

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data under certain circumstances as specified by Personal Data Protection Laws, such as when the processing is based on the Company's legitimate interests.

- **Right to Erasure or Destruction of Personal Data**

You have the right to request the deletion or destruction of your personal data, or to have it anonymized, within the scope permitted by Personal Data Protection Laws. However, in cases where the Company stores your personal data in an electronic system that may not allow for deletion or destruction, the Company may proceed to anonymize the personal data so that it can no longer be used to identify you.

- **Right to Restrict the Use of Personal Data**

You have the right to request restrictions concerning use of your personal data, for example, while the Company is verifying the accuracy of the personal data in response to your correction request, or when the personal data is no longer needed by the Company but you require it for legal purposes, within the scope permitted by Personal Data Protection Laws.

- **Right to Rectification**

You have the right to inform the Company if your personal data is inaccurate, outdated, or incomplete, and to request correction. The Company will verify and correct your personal data to ensure it is accurate, up to date, complete, and does not cause misunderstandings.



- **Right to Lodge a Complaint**

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the Personal Data Protection Commission (PDPC) and/or other relevant competent authorities if you believe that the Company has violated or failed to comply with the personal data protection laws. You may contact the Personal Data Protection Commission (PDPC) via email at saraban@pdpc.or.th

The Company reserves the right to limit your ability to exercise the above rights in accordance with Personal Data Protection Laws or other relevant laws. In some cases, the company may need to deny or be unable to comply with your request, such as when the company is required to comply with legal obligations or court orders, when the exercise of your rights may impact on the rights and freedoms of others, or when the request is deemed excessive or unreasonable.

In such cases, the company will inform you of the reasons for the denial. You may also file a complaint with the Office of the Personal Data Protection Committee and/or other competent supervisory authorities as prescribed. 10. Amendments to the Notice

The Company will review this Notice as appropriate to ensure alignment with relevant practices, regulations, and applicable laws.
